# HAPPY BIDDING!

## AUCTION RULES

### General Auction Rules

1. All sales are final. No bidder is to return any of the items to the merchant/benefactor for refund or exchange unless explicitly stated. Items are not interchangeable, nor can they be exchanged for cash.
2. Group purchases must designate one person responsible for claiming the item. Payment of group purchases may be divided.
3. Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be used within one year of the auction.
4. If there is a Minimum Bid stated, this is the lowest price that will be accepted for the item.
5. If there is a Minimum Raise stated, each increase in bid must be equal to or exceed the minimum raise stated in order to constitute a valid bid.
6. If there is a Buy It Now price stated, this is the price at which a bidder may immediately become the item's winner with no further bidding allowed.

### Gala Auction Preview Event:

1. There will be an option to "Buy It Now" on many Silent Auction items at the Preview Event. If you buy it now, we will ask for a check, cash or a completed credit card authorization form. Once payment has been received, you can take your purchase. Please be prepared by bringing cash, check or credit card. For your convenience, we have included the credit card authorization form to this booklet on page 17.
2. Auction Preview event ends February 19<sup>th</sup> at 8:00p.m. If the buy it now option has not been used or does not apply to the item, the highest bidder will be determined and the owner. At that time, payment will become due before the 25<sup>th</sup>.
3. For Sign-Up Party and Silent Auction items purchased at the Preview Event prior to the Gala & Auction, payment in full is due by Wednesday, Feb 25. If you are a successful bidder, you must pay by the 25<sup>th</sup> or the item(s) will be relisted at Gala.

### Gala & Auction Event – February 28

1. For all auction items and prizes won at the Gala & Auction event the evening of Feb. 28<sup>th</sup>, payment in full is due that evening before the conclusion of the event. Payment may be made by cash, check, VISA, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. All items and prizes must be claimed by the conclusion of the evening and cannot be left on the premises.
2. All items in the Silent Auction portion have bid sheets. Persons desiring to bid must do so by writing their name, bidder number and the amount of bid on the bid sheet. Your written bid constitutes a contract to buy.
3. Each new bid must be written on the next available blank line on the bid sheet. Each minimum raise must be equal to or exceed any minimum raise stated in order to constitute a valid bid. The closing bid circled by an auction official constitutes the winning bid.

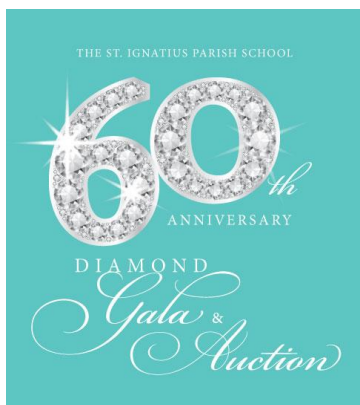
