ARE YOU GOOD WITH TECHNOLOGY? EXPERIENCED IN MIXING SOUND?

We have two areas where technical help is needed with our liturgies, and additional volunteers would be of great help.

SOUNDBOARD OPERATORS: Volunteers in this ministry work closely with the liturgy director and music leader in assuring that the people in the church can hear the priests, readers, and musicians throughout the mass. Currently, this is a need at our Sunday 9:30 and Sunday 5:30 PM masses when there are larger musical groups involved. Good hearing is crucial – including the ability to distinguish the sounds that are too loud or too quiet, quickly being able to adjust when encountering feedback, and adjusting the equalization on-the-fly when the sound is unpleasant. Anyone with experience in missing music, or with pro-audio experience is encouraged to volunteer.

LIVE-STREAM OPERATORS: Volunteers in this ministry perform a valuable service by helping to keep home-bound members connected to the parish by live-streaming our Sunday mass and other special liturgies. This ministry seeks to bring the experience of "being in church" to those who are unable to be here. Potential volunteers should be very comfortable working on a computer (PC) and have a basic understanding of the flow of the mass. Common sense about what the broadcast should look like, and even a little creativity in what to focus on during the liturgy, are both helpful. Training with an experienced person is provided in the operating of the equipment and software involved.
